NAME CALLING

It's somewhat appropriate that today's sermon falls on *Saint* Valentine's Day on the weekend after the New Orleans *Saints* won the Super Bowl!

“*Saint*” is a word we hear pretty often, especially lately with the success of Drew Brees' football team. Not only do we have *Saint* Valentine's Day on the calendar, but on March 17th we have *Saint* Patrick's Day. Then, on November 1st, there is “*All Saints Day*”.

Many of the Bibles we use show the Gospels written by *Saint* Matthew or *Saint* John. In 1997, Val Kilmer starred as Simon Templar in a movie called “*The Saint*”. Those of us who are older remember the old television show upon which that movie was based starring a pre-007 Roger Moore.

Well, what exactly is a “*saint*”? And what does it take to become one?

This morning, we are going to see that “*saint*” is a word God uses when He talks about you and me! Over the span of 2000 years or more, the definition of “*saint*” has become distorted and twisted and taken out of context to the point that it has lost its original meaning.

Vines tells us that the Greek word for *saint* is “*hagios*”— derived from the root word “*hagnos*” meaning “*chaste, sacred, clean, pure from every fault, immaculate*”. Using that definition, it's no wonder that we hear people say, “I'm no *saint*!” Yet, this morning, we will see why God has specifically chosen that word... *saint* ... as a perfect definition of YOU!

Ephesians 2:12-22 (NASB)

¹²Remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.

¹³But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

¹⁴For He Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall,

¹⁵by abolishing in His flesh the enmity, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thus establishing peace,

¹⁶and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the enmity.

¹⁷And He came and preached peace to you who were far away, and peace to those who were near;

¹⁸for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father.

¹⁹So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household,

²⁰having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone,

²¹in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord,

²²in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.
